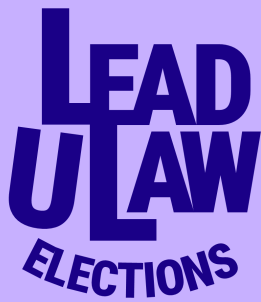

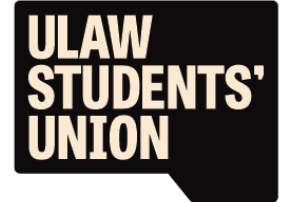

My ambitions during my time as Co-President:

1. **Help students with academic support and development.** I would do this by creating "Study with me" areas, these areas would have weekly themed study sessions with different topics. These "Study with me" session could also invite staff for mini talks
2. **Student wellbeing.** I want to create wellbeing events monthly/before any exams. The events would promote student wellbeing, give tips and motivate.
3. **Improve communication between staff and students.** This would be achieved by creating a digital suggestion box



Dear student, I am Hristo Georgiev and I am running to be YOUR Co-President of the Student Union for Academic Affairs, so let me tell you about me:

- I am in my third and final year of studying an LLB in Law with Government and Politics at the Bloomsbury campus.
- In my free time, I volunteer as a political activist in my local area in Croydon, in South London. I also work to run the Student Debating Society on my campus together with my closest friends, and we started doing this as a project because the previous society had been inactive and we were passionate about having a community for debate.
- The reason I am running in this election is simple: Everything is not what it seems to us, and it doesn't work. Student-led and student-friendly change is needed urgently.
- Ulaw prides itself on ranking 10th in the UK in 2024 for teaching by the NSS, yet there are practices that often do little to ensure every student gets effective support in learning or improving. Students see a lack of proper understanding about modules or options after graduating. New students cite Employment opportunities as a primary reason to join the university, yet the Employability Service provides a small volume of jobs, inaccessible to newer, less experienced students. In a cost of living and youth unemployment crisis, this is simply unacceptable.

So...What is to be done?

1. **"Your Options" Welcome events** will be informational events introduced for all new and current students **each semester on each campus**, to enable **better understanding of modules, and qualification routes** students may be willing to take after graduating (**SQE, BPC, vacation schemes and more**)
2. **An Administrative Complaints System** will be created **to address student grievances**, where the SU Co-Presidents will represent **one point of contact**, and **will advocate for students' interests by fulfilling desired changes and casework**. **An outside NUS complaints system** will be set up for addressing **formal society grievances** and to **avoid the Student Union from "grading its own homework"**.
3. **Academic Coaches and "How to Ace your assessment" sessions will be scrapped**, replacing them with an **Academic Mentorship Scheme**. In this, a post-election policy team will work to **analyse student underperformance, disengagement** and focus on **interaction, intervention and support**. **Students** with a strong academic record and lecturers will co-operate to help achieve this, in exchange for professional commendations.
4. **A Semi-Annual Quality of Teaching Review will be launched**, focusing on **assessment of teaching methods** by lecturers **through consultation with students** about experiences during Workshops and Large Groups across all campuses. **Class Rep involvement will be incentivised** to ensure **scrutiny** and to **add value to the role**.
5. The Employability Service will be reformed through the introduction of a **Professional Development Plan** for Students. This will include a long-term goal of **providing accessible work experience opportunities to all students**, an **Employment Coordination Committee** advising on student work credentials.
6. Academic development and advocacy skills will be enhanced through **a federal debating and mooted society body on all campuses, co-operating with major universities nationally**. Additionally, **reform on transparency and expanding student democracy will be prioritised**.

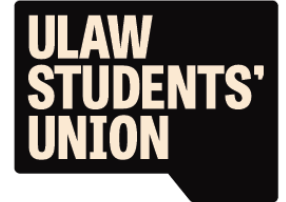

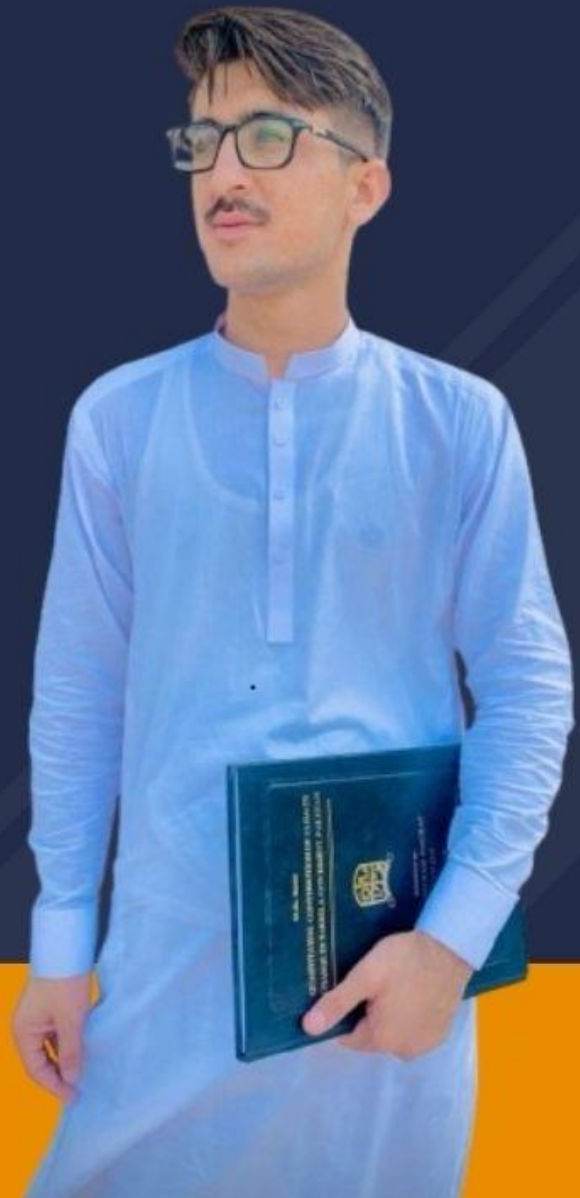
